TOPIC: INCREASING AWARENESS SURROUNDING SUPPORT SERVICES FOR NURSING

STUDENTS WITH MENTAL AND LEARNING DISABILITIES.

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WHEREAS, in 2020, a study demonstrated that 47.2% of nursing students experienced a moderate

level of stress while another 25% of students experienced high levels of stress due to

nursing curriculum and clinical placement; and

WHEREAS, nursing education and clinical placement are high stress environments which place

nursing students at an increased risk for developing or aggravating pre-existing mental

illness and/or disabilities; and

WHEREAS, nursing students with diagnosed anxiety, learning disabilities, and mental illness

continue to increase yet very few have information regarding nursing accommodations

and other support services available to them; and

WHEREAS, many students with disabilities are more likely to drop out of their program of study due

to lack of help and resources to help them be successful; and

WHEREAS, tailoring accommodations to specific needs assists individuals in overcoming challenges

related to disabilities, learning differences, or other unique circumstances, promoting fairness and equity in education through the removal of barriers and the establishment

of an inclusive learning environment where all students have the opportunity to

succeed; and

WHEREAS, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Iowa Association of Nursing Student (IANS) demonstrate an ongoing

commitment to increase awareness among the community on the need for support

services for nursing students with mental and learning disabilities; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the IANS encourage school chapters to collaborate with their nursing programs and

other campus organizations, underlining the importance of promoting awareness of

nursing students with learning and mental disabilities and the importance implementing

support services for these students; and be it further

RESOLVED, that IANS send a copy of this resolution to American Nurses Association, American

Association of Colleges of Nursing, Iowa Nursing Association, National League for

Nursing, Organization for Associate Degree Nursing, American Holistic Nurses

Association, National Association of Nursing Students (NSNA), United States Department

of Education, and all others deemed appropriate by the IANS Board of Directors.
